## 2013-14 Healthcare Improvements

In 2013-14, thanks to your donations, the Hospital received:

**Aboriginal Wellness Program:** Cookware.

**Diagnostic Imaging:** Staff fridge.

**Emergency Unit:** LifeSense multi-parameter monitor.

**Extended Care Unit:** Staff fridge.

**Laboratory:** Microscope for semen analysis.

**Medical Center:** Bariatric scale.

**Medicine Unit:** Mattress overlays.

**Obstetrics:** Eight baby bassinets, and two birthing balls.

**Occupational Therapy:** Craft bundle, fine motor bundle, gross motor bundle, and a sensory bundle.

**Pediatrics:** Thermometers, feeding pump, vital signs monitor, pediatric wheel-chair, a television and DVD player.

**Physiotherapy:** Full length spine model, and a recumbent bike.

**Psychiatry:** Table for activities.

**Speech Language Pathology:** Bubble machine, switch kit, jelly lamp, and an iPad.

**Surgery:** Doppler, two bedside chairs, two bedside hip chairs, and two bedside footstools.



## Diavik Multi-Year Funding Agreement

In 2013, Diavik Diamond Mines and the Stanton Territorial Hospital Foundation were very pleased to announce a new funding partnership. Under the agreement, Diavik will donate \$45,000 to the Foundation over the next three years.

“At Diavik, we focus on health and safety by doing all we can to prevent injuries and accidents. 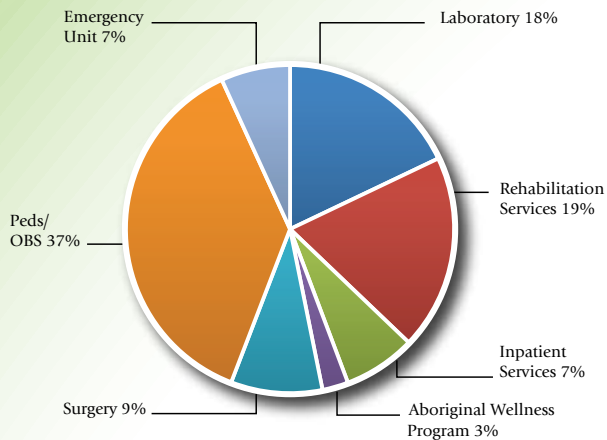

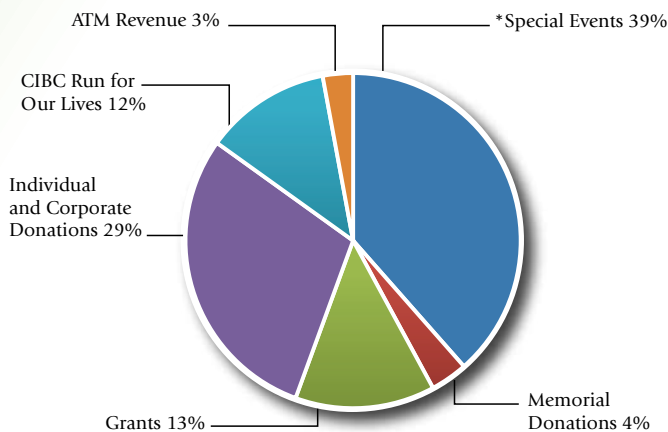
